Material List

Surfaces:

- 3 large sheets of good quality water colour paper (Arches 140lb cold press, Winsor & Newton or Fabriano artistico. I have extra Fabriano Artisitico 140 lb paper that I can sell you.

Paints:

Watercolour paints (professional quality is best) Winsor & Newton, Daniel Smith, Hobein). The colours listed are just a suggestion. Bring what you use and add some new colours to try if you like.

- Hansa Yellow Light or medium
- Winsor Yellow
- Indian Yellow or New Gambogue
- Quinacidone red or any red you like eg. Alizarin Crimson, Pyrol Red
- Quinacridone pink or Bright Pink
- Prussian Blue or Antwerp Blue or Cobalt or French Ultramarine blue
- Dioxine purple or any purple you have
- Quinacridone Burnt Orange
- Raw Sienna

Brushes:

- 1" or 2" flat wash brush
- Round brushes #6,8,10 or anything you have close to those sizes.

Other Items:

- 2 Large wooden, plexiglass or chloroplast boards for painting on
- Masking tape
- Large watercolour palette for your paints with good mixing area
- Small spray bottle
- Box of kleenex
- paper towels
- HB pencil
- White eraser
- Fine sharpie black pen
- 2 large water containers
- sharpener
- Metal ruler (20" or more)
- old white face cloth
