Material List

Surfaces:

Gallery width canvases or wood panels in the sizes recommended below. If possible, cover the surface with a thin underpainting in a warm colour. Yellow ochre, crimson or burnt sienna. We will be painting small sizes suitable for gift giving or for pairing little splashes of colour to brighten up your own home.

- Two 8" x 8" canvases
- One 6" x 12" or close to this size
- One or two 12" x 12" or 10" x 10"

Paints:

My preferred acrylic paint colours are listed below. Please don't feel obliged to get them all. I like Golden and/or Liquitex brand. I tend to use heavy body paints as colours are sharper and richer. Bring whatever you have as well.

- Titanium white
- Primary magenta
- Hansa yellow/Indian yellow - if not available any shade of cadmium yellow will do
- cadmium red or orange
- Ultramarine blue
- Paynes grey (optional)
- Teal
- Burnt sienna

Brushes:

- 2-3 Flat tipped synthetic angled brushes ranging from $\frac{1}{4}$ " - 1" (Zen brand brushes \$4.25 from DeSerres work quite well).
- One or two long and short palette knives - plastic ones are fine.

Other Items:

- A light coloured piece of chalk
- Palette for acrylics (disposable pad is easier)
- J cloths, ruler,
- $\frac{3}{4}$ " - 1" Green or masking tape if using paper.
- 2 empty yogurt tubs for water
